


Wire Harness Routing Precaution



Do not secure the accessory harness to the SRS harness. (except for instruction cases.)



Push the connectors and terminals together until they lock.



Do not pull the harness to unplug the connectors.



Install removed connectors in their original location.



Do not pull the harness.



Secure the accessory harness as shown.



Do not pinch the harness.



Cut off the excess wire tie.

- Always use Acura Long Life Antifreeze/Coolant Type 2. Using a non-Honda coolant can result in corrosion, causing the cooling system to malfunction or fail.
- To avoid burning out the element, do not operate the engine block heater until it is installed in the vehicle and you have added coolant.
- 1. Disconnect the negative cable from the battery.










RADIATOR DRAIN PLUG
